Work towards targets drawn from the 2016-19 Strategic Plan

- 100% of students who are capable to achieve a 'C' or higher in English, Mathematics and Science
- 100% of students in Years 3 and 5 to be above the NMS in Reading, Writing and Numeracy
- 60% of students in Years 3 and 5 to be in the Upper Two Bands in Reading, Writing and Numeracy

**Our initiatives include**

- Analyse 2016 NAPLAN to identify students in Years 4 and 6 who are below NMS in Reading, Writing and/or Numeracy. Supplement the classroom learning program with the Intervention Program to focus instruction on these students needs
- Analyse data from the Semester Achievement Report in English, Maths and Science to identify students who are at risk of not achieving a 'C' in the end of Semester Reports. Supplement the classroom learning program with the Student Services Program to focus instruction on these student's needs.
- Analyse data from the Semester Achievement Report to identify students who are achieving an A or B (or have the potential to be). Supplement the classroom learning program with the Student Services Program to focus instruction on these student's needs to realise their potential.
- Continue to implement the Albany Hills Mathematics Program, with an emphasis on reasoning and problem solving.
- Implement the Albany Hills Writing and Spelling Programs. This includes a curriculum program and a specified approach to pedagogy, including assessment.
- Implement the Albany Hills Science Program that provides for an inquiry approach to learning as well as the application of literacy and numeracy skills
- Implement a student engagement program that supports students at risk of not achieving to expectations


**Our school will improve student outcomes by**

Strategy	Allocation
Conduct collaborative planning sessions with all year levels. Costs are associated with providing in-school time to teachers to engage in team planning and decision making	\$51 290
Utilise the Head of Curriculum to lead the implementation of the Mathematics Program and to collaborate with the Master Teacher and Teacher Librarian on the Writing and Spelling programs	\$62 000
Employ a Teacher Aide to assist students to engage in the program of learning	\$27 000
Supplement the staffing allocation to employ a Lead Teacher: Student Engagement (part-time) to organise and oversee the Intervention program	\$54 000
Employ a Lead Teacher Science to oversee and support the establishment of the Science (including Literacy in Science) program	\$41 000
